Cleaning the trim and visible portion of the image tile:

The OpenView trim and visible portion of the image tile can be cleaned without removing the trim.

Use a microfiber cloth and for more difficult smudges, a mild diluted dish soap solution and gently wipe the surfaces clean.

IMPORTANT: Always <u>turn fixture off</u> before cleaning or trim removal.

Use a damp cloth only.

DO NOT LET LIQUID RUN UNDERNEATH TRIM AND INTO ELECTRICAL PARTS

If any solution remains, wipe it off with a dry microfiber cloth.

For very difficult smudges hard to remove with water and soap, a microfiber cloth <u>dampened only</u> with isopropyl alcohol can be used.

Remember:

- Always turn OpenView off before cleaning.
- Use a damp microfiber cloth only.
- <u>Do not let liquid run down into electrical parts.</u>
- Do not use an abrasive cloth or cleaner.
- Do not vigorously scrub.
- Gently rub when wiping the image tile and trim.

Removing the trim:

If, for example, something has slipped between the trim and the image and the trim needs to be removed:

The trim is held to the light box by:

- 1. button-fix type 2 hardware, which is designed to release when pulled, and
- 2. four safety cords, two near the top and two near the bottom, which will need to be released by hand. NOTE: Smaller sizes may have only one set of cords.

IMPORTANT: Trim removal requires two people:

- for smaller sizes, one to hold the trim while a second person releases the safety cords, and
- for larger sizes, one on each side to remove the trim and release the safety cords.

IMPORTANT: Always turn fixture off before cleaning or trim removal.

To release the trim:

Grasp the trim near the top <u>on both sides</u> and pull it <u>directly</u> away from the light box.

NOTE: This will require both people for larger fixtures.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT PULL ON ONE SIDE ONLY!

then continue towards the bottom of the fixture until the trim is fully released.

To release the safety cords:

Once the trim is released, it needs to be lifted slightly to relieve the tension on the safety cords so they can be unhooked from the green buttons.

NOTE: For larger fixtures, each person will hold the trim and unhook the cords on their respective sides.

To reinstall the trim:

First, trim is centered over the light box and safety cables are attached.

NOTE: Cords attach to the green buttons.

NOTE: Once again, this will require two people for larger fixtures

Then, grasping the trim near the top on both sides:

- 1. line up the buttons on the trim with the catches on the light box, and
- 2. push both sides of trim near the top firmly toward the light box until the button-fix hardware latches,
- 3. then continue pushing the trim in where it is needed until all hardware is firmly latched.

IMPORTANT: WHERE POSSIBLE, PUSH TRIM IN ON BOTH SIDES AT THE SAME TIME!

Maintaining the LED's:

The LED's themselves are maintenance-free.

Our LED's have a conservative life of 40,000 hours. This lifetime is based on a functional drop to 80% of the original output.

Please contact Sky Factory if a problem arises with their functioning.

If LED's reach their end of life, they can be replaced on site by a qualified electrician.
